

Dear Brethren and Sisters, May we take this opportunity to express our gratitude for being called to serve as the ward bishopric. We are always impressed with the Saints willingness to follow the church leadership and sacrifice of their time and means.

We wish to speak to you about reverence in our meetinghouse and outline a program we believe will be pleasing to the Lord and uplifting to us all. Beginning with the Sacrament service of April 12 a concentrated effort will be asked of each of you to assist the bishipric in upgrading the reverence in our meetinghouse. And the following are some of the ways we all can take part.

1 So that parents can teach the principle of reverence to their children we ask that all family members sit together during Sacrement meeting.

2 All families are asked to make reverence a topic for family home evening discussion to determine ways in which they can contribute to reverence in our buildings.

3 A challenge has been issued to the Aaronic Priesthood to be at the chapel at least 15 minutes before the meeting is to begin to assume their duties as ushers and to aid in officiating at the sacrement table. We know they must rely on their parents to arrive early. So we ask those parents to plan their schedule accordingly so transportation can be arranged.


4 With the exception of parents with babies needing attention we ask that all members attend their classes and not congregate in the halls and fover.

5 The bishopric will be on the stand 5 minutes early and will be at the chapel doors 15 minutes before the meeting is to begin to greet the members.

6 Prayer meeting will be held with those on the sacrement program before the meeting. This will include the music director and organist. It will be 15 minutes before.

7 All auxillary leaders have been asked to take part in this effort by encouraging reverence in their meetings.

8 May we also discourage leaving the chapel area during the meeting except those with babies needing attention. Again the bishopric commends all of you and ask for your prayers and participation in the reverence program.



With the finest, truest pen.


Expand thou, my mind.
