

Our Missionaries At Home and Abroad

THE FOLLOWING COMUNICATIONS WERE RECIEVED BY"THE LIAHONA"FROM THOSE REPRESENTING OUR WARD AS FULL TIME MISSIONARIES AWAY FROM HOME:

Al Robels, an investigator of ours, has experienced something we teach and believe, but which very few of us have ever experienced. Al Robels, in 1975, died for 92 seconds! As he described his journey into the afterlife, Elder Joyner, my companion, was awe struck and felt we should teach Al the second discussion (the plan of salvation). Everything finally made sense to Al! All the years he searched in other religions, Al never was given a straight answer, until Elder Joyner and I presented him the restored gospel.

During the discussion, my companion felt that he should pay particular attention to certain concepts in which we would be able to have a personal view of the trek into the unknown. When Al was shown the illustration of the pre-existence, he stared, left his chair and held the flip chart. "Do only Mormons have pictures like these?" he asked. He described to us what he had seen in great detail, and pointed out minor differences in the picture. We explained the illustration was only an artist's idea of the concept from the discussion.

He recounted, "...for 92 seconds, I left my body, looked at myself, saw that I was whole; and yet, when I looked at my body, my hand was missing! Then I went to what I felt to be a peaceful place, a place where I wanted to stay. I saw what you missionaries teach! I was addressed by a person.....not a mist or a bright light, but a person! I was told that it was not time yet, that I would have to go back, and I felt myself dropping like I did out of a plane as a paratrooper. The jolt of the Electric shock the doctor used to start my heart awakened me. I then passed out, and awoke three days later in the hospital. This has helped me so much; thank you!"

I felt I should have thanked him; these kind of times make my mission worth it. (From a letter written by Elder Joseph Mark Atchley, October 16, 1981.)

"I suddenly became acutely aware of where we were and what we were doing one night about a week ago. We had followed a path through a banana grove to a hut where the family lived that we were going to teach and show a film. The cook-fire was outside, the water pipe was outside and the film and lesson would be outside too. There was one light bulb, so we had electrical power. Family members kept coming out of the dark banana grove, each carrying something to sit on. We strung up a sheet and the film began. I looked up at the stars and at the cook

fire and at the twenty or more people we were bringing a gospel message to and thought of how the Lord was using us as His instruments to teach more than 20 people, in the dark, in a jungle, in a foreign language, under the stars in the Dominican Republic. What a wonderful situation to be in - how peaceful! (From a letter written by Elder Robert and Sister Winnie Atchley, October 1981.)

There isn't enough room in 4 books of paper to express the joys, blessings, experiences and challenges of the mission. But on these few_lines, I'd like to share my ideas on the keys to missionary work and spreading the gospel.

First is LOVE.

We have the gospel because our Heavenly Father loves us, and it is our desire to share that love with our brothers.

Second is DESIRE.

He blesses us with opportunities when we have desires to share.

Third is FAITH.

To receive the blessings of conversion we have to believe that others will accept. We must believe the Spirit will touch their hearts and lives.

Fourth is PRAYER.

We express our faith and desire through honest and sincere prayer. Prayer is a real POWER and IT WORKS! We can do anything by prayer.

Fifth (This is the clincher!) MEMBERS! The missionaries and the members are a team; we're interdependent. There is no greater joy than to watch a member light up with the love of the gospel as a friend or associate accepts the gospel of Jesus Christ.

The gospel is a great lesson in <u>love</u> and <u>brotherhood</u>.


MISSIONARIES CONTINUED

AND THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST by G. J. Satterlee

Once again Octobers windy gate has blown open before us allowing Autumn to take possession of the season! Already Autumn leaves are in a frantic race to change colour and blanket the ground! Soon little hobgoblins will be wandering from door to door seeking baskets full of goodies. Still others will gather together, arrayed in costume, and enjoy various festivities from ducking for apples to unravelling frightening tales in dimly lit drawing rooms! Inevitably too, the pranksters will



be about engaging in harmless mischief, doing their works in darkness. Yes, wonderous Halloween has returned! That mystical magical celebration fashioned for children...or is it? The childish apparitions which

characterize the season were once not so long ago regarded with awe by adults as well...and in many parts of the world still are! From whence then do we derive the prevailing practices of the season?

Although many of our present-day practices have obscured the true origins of Halloween, many countries have preserved the meanings behind the traditions. But though most of our scholars and historians would insist that it began around the 7th century a.d., the aspects which characterize Halloween actually date back several millenia before this world existed.

It was there in the council of the heavens that Lucifer, the son of the morning, in arrogance exalted himself above all that is called God by asserting that he could act as saviour of the world and through force, bring about the salvation of mankind! Of course the selfcentered plan of Lucifer was rejected in fayor of the loving plan of Jesus Christ which allows all mankind the priveledge to live as they may with total salvation being made available to those who accept the sacrifices he suffered in pain and humility for us: Lucifer was cast out and because he decieved one third of the host of heaven into following him, his name became SATAN. "And he became Satan, yea even the DEVIL, the father of all lies, to decieve, and to blind men, and to lead them captive at his will, even as many as would not hearken unto my voice." (Moses 4:4) This was the begining of Satan's deception among men-

The Lord stated that his work and glory was to bring to pass the eternal life of man. (Moses 1:39) The beloved apostle John testified that eternal life would come to those who truly know God and Christ. (John 17:3) The prophet Joseph Smith proclaimed it would be impossible for a man to be saved in ignorance.....and it is Satan who promotes ignorance among men in every concievable form! To Adam's earliest posterity he appeared, proclaiming himself to be the son of God and influencing them to be carnal, sensual, and devilish. (Moses 5:13) Thus establishing the pattern for worshiping false dieties for centuries to come! In order to reinforce the credability of his false Gods, Satan also promoted a belief in false devils! (i.e. Batwinged, reptilianskined, horned headed, tail wielding beings) Satan, in his true form, was free to influence great multitudes unsuspected. History is replete with civilizations in the grips of apostasy which have developed customs based on such false ideas. These customs are called SUPERSTITIONS. Merrian Webster defines superstition as: "..beliefs or practices resulting from ignorance, fear of the unknown or trust in magic or chance. An irrational abject attitude of mind toward nature, the unknown or God."

By the meridian of time, false teachings and superstitious beliefs were wide spread even among God's chosen people. During his earthly ministry, Christ taught the Isrealites: "..if you continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free." (John 8:31-32) The heavens poured forth it's blessing of light and knowledge to all those who would accept it and the earth, for a period, enjoyed the freedom offered by Christ. Still, some false doctrines persisted within the church from converts clinging to their old ways. These, the Apostles combatted until their assassinations, which resulted in the eventual withdrawal of revelation and the priesthood authority of God from the earth! What was left of the body of the church was a mere shell of it's former self infested with the worms, maggots and disease of ignorance and apostasy. Dead without the spirit of truth to give it life!

Without continuous revelation to guide them, many became self-appointed leaders in the church and Christisnity underwent innumerable changes and compromises in doctrine. Among the many heresies which this new Christianity adopted from the pagans, was the belief in vampires, were-creatures and other related beings. These monsters came more vividly to life with the encouragement of the priests who would sell religious icons and blessings..etc..to ward them away. (obviously a false church with no real authority could not cast out REAL devils and so replaced them with IMAGINARY ones!) The Papacy gave it's endorsement on the authenticity of such creatures in a document entitled MALLEUS MALEFICA-RUM published in 1489.

Pagan practices were not so far removed from the doctrines of this church of the dark ages. The Papacy was not so much concerned with correcting false beliefs as it was with substituting a "christian" motivation for them: The Druids were a group of pagans who occupied most of northern and western Europe. They noted two inportaint feasts: Beltane on May 1st and the Autumn festival of Samhain on the last day of October. A supernatural element was a part of the Autumn festival for Druids tried to placate the lord of death. It was believed that he allowed the spirits, both good and evil, of those who died during the last 12 months to return to their homes at this time. The church also had a celebration honoring it's dead instituted by Pope Boniface IV in 615 a.d. called: The Feast of all Holy Martyrs. In 844 a.d. Pope Gregory IV transferred the celebration from May 1st to Nov. 1st, to christianize the pagan holiday. Pope Sixtus IV established it as a Holy day of obligation for the entire latin church giving it a litorgical vigil and octave in 1484. Pope Sylvester II in 1084 approved and recommended the following day, Nov. 2, as a day to honor all the departed ones, (Omnium Defunctorum) not only the saints. Thus Novembers 1st and 2nd became ALL SAINTS DAY and ALL SOULS DAY respectively, superseded by ALL HALLOWS EVE on Oct. 31st, or "HALLOWEEN" as we know it.

The customs of ALL HALLOWS EVE were largely derived from its pagan counterpart, such as the notion that the souls in purgatory and living dead creatures are allowed to wander the earth on this night. It became common practice to honor departed relatives by visiting the cemetary bearing food and tiny gifts to place on the graves, but fearing the vengeance of some departed soul overlooked, such provisions were also made available on doorsteps. Of course, craftier persons, (perhaps those responsible for promoting these superstitions) realized the potential for robbing and pillaging disguised as the apparitions which were so feared. Any home found not providing this offering was in jeopardy of vandalism by the masquerading monsters. This began the evolution of our modern day practice of "Trick or Treat."

Thus this "children's holiday" originated in the fears of superstitious men, men who were blinded by Satan's deception. A holiday which testifies of the apostasy of the early christian church. Yet the day of reckoning shall come when before all mankind, Lucifer's masquerade will draw to a close..."They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying .. is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake Kingdoms..?" (Isa. 14:16)



In observing the modern celebration of Halloween it is well to preserve fun traditions of masquerades and Trick or Treat, Jack o' Lanterns, and things which go bump in the night....however if you should find yourself harboring BELIEFS in superstitions, it's better to remember the statement of Paul the Apostle: "When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things." (1 Corin. 13:11)


